Description: As you wander in your herb garden while late fall is naturally drying some of the last savoury herbs to be harvested, the image of a fresh Béarnaise sauce comes to mind. Still, freshness is at its core as both the nose and the palate finish bright with a firm acidity just as with the finest Béarnaise.
